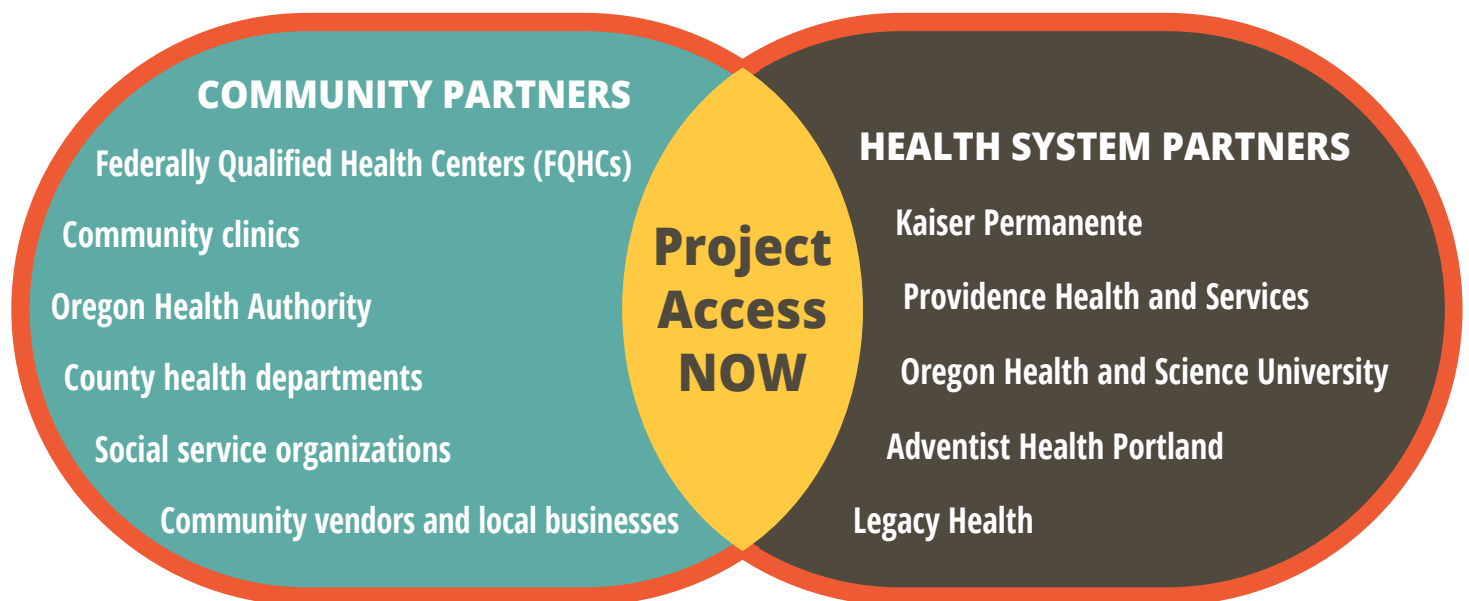

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## Project Access NOW's suite of programs follow patients throughout their health care journey.

Providing culturally-specific support	➔ <i>More than 80% of clients are immigrants, people of color, and/or speak English as a second language.</i>
Reducing emergency room usage and unnecessary hospital stays and supporting patient discharge (so vulnerable patients may avoid unnecessary extended hospital stays)	➔ <i>Last year, <b>1,707 hospital days were avoided</b> because patients had the support they needed to get and stay healthy. Additionally, the organization <b>secured 10,000+ hotel nights</b> for vulnerable individuals and aided in rapid response to crises such as COVID-19 and wildfire.</i>
Increasing access to health care and prescriptions, particularly for those without health insurance	➔ <i>Last year, more than <b>\$5.69 million in prescription drugs</b> were made accessible to low-income clients.</i>
Supporting health care providers so they can focus on providing quality care.	➔ <i>Project Access NOW has <b>30+ staff</b> and more than a <b>decade</b> of experience in the industry.</i>

## OUR PROGRAMS

### **CLASSIC CARE COORDINATION**

connects uninsured and low-income individuals with donated primary and specialty care.

### **PHARMACY BRIDGE**

offers low- or no- cost medications to uninsured and underinsured patients.

### **PREMIUM ASSISTANCE**

pays health insurance premiums for clients who earn slightly too much to qualify for Medicaid, but too little to afford premiums and out-of-pocket costs.

### **OUTREACH, ENROLLMENT, AND ACCESS**

helps uninsured Oregonians enroll in health insurance and navigate the federal marketplace and other qualifying state programs.

### **C3 COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM**

connects low-income patients to the resources they need for safe hospital or emergency room discharge and a return to wellness.
